What is the Holiday Basket and Teen Gift Drive?

In conjunction with the Shoreline PTA Council, schools across Shoreline donate food and gift items that are given to over 500 families in need. Boxes of food, paper goods, toiletries, toys and teen gift cards are assembled and distributed to families to assist during the holiday season.

How can you help?

- **VOLUNTEER:**
